Initial Triage Worksheet

Utilize this form to triage the student and determine whether the student should go to the sick room or well room.

1. What is the main reason the student is coming to the health office?
 - **Minor bleeding, disinfection of cuts or scrapes, application of adhesive bandages, a loose tooth, dry lips or skin, and hunger or thirst can be managed in the classroom.**
2. Does the student have diabetes, asthma, or migraines?
 - **If unknown, you may find this information on the Medical Alert or on Infinite Campus. If yes, send to the well room.**
3. Ask the student if they have medication in the health office. You may also find this information on the Medical Alert.
 - **If student has medication in the health office, send to well room for administration.**
4. If it is suspected a student's symptoms may be the result of an acute injury/condition, the school nurse must be notified to provide further direction.
 - **These students will be treated in the well room. Refer to PUB-663 before moving the student.**
5. If the student has any symptoms of illness, send to the sick room, unless the symptoms can be attributed to another condition.
6. Is the student reporting they have been around someone who tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
 - **If yes, proceed to sick room.**
7. Is the student reporting they have tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
 - **If yes, proceed to sick room.**
